## UIM Superlicence application procedure opened for the 2024 racing season

Dear Ladies, Dear Sirs,

Class 1, XCAT, F1, F2, F4 and Aquabike drivers the UIM Superlicence application procedure for the 2024 racing season has been launched, and interested drivers can, as of now, apply for their 2024 UIM Superlicence.

A new Boat Class," **E1**", will feature on the 2024 UIM Racing Calendar, and interested drivers must **obtain UIM E1 Pilot Academy certification** to be eligible for obtaining an UIM E1 Superlicence, which will entitle them to participate in the UIM E1 World Championship. The Drivers having been involved in the specific E1 Training activities at the UIM E1 Pilot Academy can apply with immediate effect for their 2024 UIM E1 Superlicence, as per enclosed procedure.

Please note that the application deadlines set in the specific Class Rules have to be respected strictly.

In the private area of the UIM website <a href="http://www.uim.sport/">http://www.uim.sport/</a> each National Authority can enter the UIM Superlicence Applications of their drivers on-line and upload relevant documents as per indications in the Superlicence Application Procedure document. Please note that **NO** Superlicence application will be taken into account unless it has been entered via the UIM on-line portal.

Please note that the UIM Superlicence fees for Class 1, XCAT, F1,F2, F4 and Aquabike remain unchanged for the 2024 racing season; the UIM E1 Superlicence fee has been set at the same level as the Class 1 and XCAT Superlicences.

As regards applicants for the UIM Class 1 Superlicence, the corresponding fee (and medical expertise fee, if applicable) will be collected from the UIM Class 1 Promoter partner, Powerboat P1.

Speaking about the insurance cover for Aquabike drivers, please note that in the event your drivers cannot obtain a Civil Responsibility insurance as per Aquabike rule 203.02.02, the UIM and H2O Racing will also this year offer the Aquabike drivers the possibility to take out a *Global Civil Responsibility Insurance Policy* which will cover the Aquabike drivers for the 2024 Aquabike Circuit World Championship events exclusively.
